RAGGING

RAGGING IS PROHIBITED

- Ragging is Prohibited As Per Act 26 Of A.P. Legislative Assembly, 1997
- Ragging entails heavy fines and / or Imprisonment
- Ragging invokes suspension and dismissal from the college.
- All the students must carry their Identity Cards and show them when demanded
- The Principal / Managing Committee may visit the Hostels and inspect the rooms at any time

ANTI-RAGGING

Ragging is a serious offence that is strictly prohibited under the UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009. It is a punishable act under the provisions of the Indian Penal Code. Our college has established an Anti-Ragging Cell to comply with these regulations and ensure a safe, inclusive, and harassment-free learning environment. This cell is dedicated to preventing and addressing any incidents of ragging, promoting a culture of mutual respect, and safeguarding the well-being of all students. Through awareness programmes, strict monitoring and prompt action, the Anti-Ragging Cell upholds the value of discipline, dignity and harmony within the institution.

OBJECTIVES

- To create awareness among students about the detrimental effects of ragging and the severe consequences of engaging in such behaviour.
- To provide a safe and secure environment for all students, particularly freshmen, ensuring they are free from intimidation, harassment or victimisation.
- To establish accessible and confidential channels for students to report ragging incidents without fear of reprisal.
- To respond promptly and effectively to any reported incidents of ragging through proper investigation procedures.
- To provide counselling services to both victims of ragging and reformed students who have engaged in ragging behaviour.
- To conduct regular anti-ragging campaigns, orientation programs and workshops to foster a culture of mutual respect and dignity.
- To ensure compliance with all UGC regulations and Supreme Court directives related to preventing ragging in higher educational institutions.

MEASURES FOR PREVENTION OF RAGGING

- (a) Ragging within and outside the campus is totally banned.
- (b) Every student has to fill an affidavit. The affidavit should be filled up and signed by the candidate.
- (c) A printed affidavit, preferably both in English and Hindi and/or in one of the regional languages and the affidavit should be signed by the parent/guardian of the applicant.
- (d) The applicant must submit a document along with the School Leaving Certificate/Character certificate which shall include a report on the behavioural pattern of the applicant. So that the institution can keep intense watch upon the student who has a negative entry in this regard.
- (e) Each batch of freshers should be divided into small groups and each such group shall be assigned to a member of staff. Such staff members should interact individually with each member on a regular basis to ascertain the problems/

difficulties, if any faced by the fresher's in the Institution and extent necessary help.

ACTIONS TO BE TAKEN AGAINST STUDENTS FOR INDULGING AND ABETTING RAGGING IN THE INSTITUTE

- (a) A strong, exemplary and justifiably harsh punishment would be meted out to the persons indulged in ragging to act as a deterrent against recurrence of such incidents.
- (b) In case of any incident of ragging, a First Information Report (FIR) would be filed without exception by the institutional authorities with the local police authorities.
- (c) Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offense as established the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any or any combination of the following:-
 - (i) Cancellation of admission.
 - (ii) Suspension from attending classes.
 - (iii) Withdrawing other benefits.
 - (iv) Debarring from appearing in any test / examination or other evaluation process.
 - (v) Withholding results.
 - (vi) Rustication from the institution.
